### **Classes and Categories**

#### **Pre-School**

- 285 A colour collage
- 286 Grow a yellow flower
- 287 An original painting – mounted on card
- 288 An original drawing – mounted on card

#### **Reception**

- 289 A rainbow of colour painting
- 290 Build a colourful tower (photograph of work to be entered)
- 291 An original painting – mounted on card
- 292 An original drawing – mounted on card

#### **Years 1 & 2**

- 293 A Mondrian inspired primary colour collage
- 294 An observation painting/drawing of summer colour around you
- 295 An original painting – mounted on card
- 296 An original drawing – mounted on card

#### **Years 3 & 4**

- 297 A colourful fabric collage
- 298 An exploration of the primary colour red (any medium can be entered)
- 299 An original painting – mounted on card
- 300 An original drawing – mounted on card

#### **Years 5 & 6**

- 301 A painting using and exploring complimentary colour
- 302 A felt tip dot and spot drawing using complimentary colour
- 303 An original painting – mounted on card
- 304 An original drawing – mounted on card

### **Years 7 – 9**

- 305 A drawing or painting exploring yellow
- 306 A drawing or painting to show mood/emotion through colour
- 307 An original drawing or painting – mounted on card

### **Years 10 & 11**

- 308 A textiles and or fashion project (could be from a school project or GCSE)
- 309 Design and technology product (could be from a school project or GCSE)
- 310 An original drawing or painting – mounted on card

### **Open – Young photographer, baker, gardener and artist (pre-school to year 11)**

- 311 Make a colour wheel in any form (a photo of the work can be entered)
- 312 A painting to be hung at Trew Art in Claygate
- 313 An exploration of the colour blue (any medium can be entered)
- 314 A colourful mini garden
- 315 Cut flower/flowers or herbs in a pot/container
- 316 Make and decorate a cake inspired by the theme ‘colour’
- 317 A photograph of a landscape or seascape – mounted on card
- 318 A photograph of a living subject, human or animal – mounted on card
- 319 Design a poster for next year’s Claygate Flower and Village Show 2027
- 320 Write an acrostic poem using the word ‘COLOUR’
- 321 One or more vegetable or fruit grown by you (the more colourful the better)

**Group Work** -your choice of subject and medium. A group can be two or more children and individual points cannot be scored from these categories.

- 322 Pre-school children
- 323 Majority of group in Reception
- 324 Majority of group in Years 1 and 2
- 325 Majority of group in Years 3 and 4
- 326 Majority of group in Years 5 and 6
- 327 Majority of group in Years 7 – 9
- 328 Majority of group Years 10 and 11
- 329 Any age – garden produce grown by your group

### **Junior section: Points, Prizes and Cups**

Point awarded: 1st = 10 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 8 points, 3rd = 6 points,

Highly commended = 4 points

Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup> prize £3, 2<sup>nd</sup> prize £2, 3<sup>rd</sup> prize £1

**A cup to keep:** awarded for the most points gained in each class.

**The Junior Committee Cup:** awarded for best overall contribution, to someone who has not otherwise been awarded a cup or trophy.

**The Fawcus Cup:** awarded to the school with the most first prizes.

**The Brian Anscorb Cup:** a commemorative cup for the best exhibit in the judges' opinion.

**The CRGT Cup:** best exhibit in the spirit of this year's theme, 'Colour'.

**Group Work Trophies:** awarded for the best in each age range.

**For preschool children,** a certificate will be awarded instead of prize money.

**For group work,** certificates will be awarded instead of prize money.

**Points to remember:**

- Enter online at [www.claygateflowershow.co.uk](http://www.claygateflowershow.co.uk) by midnight on Monday 6th July.
- Your exhibits should be brought to the Junior end of the marquee, between 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM on Saturday 11th July.
- Paper exhibits, pictures and photographs need to be mounted on card so that we can display your work effectively. They may also be laminated.
- Write your name, school and phone number on the back of all exhibits.
- Only one entry allowed per person per Flower Show class.
- Exhibits created at home or school can be entered by individuals.
- Exhibits must not have been entered into the Flower Show from previous years.
- Please resist the urge to help your children too much. The judges do like to see the children's own work.
- Please stick to the description in the Categories. Entries cannot be judged fairly and equally if the Category is not adhered to. If the Category is not followed said items can be displayed but may not be judged.
- Paintings are judged if the picture is painted using a brush (oil pastels are deemed to be paint).
- Drawings are judged if the picture is drawn using a pencil or pen (this includes felt tips).

**Don't forget!**

- All junior cups will be presented in the main arena at 4:00 PM.
- Please make sure that someone is at the arena to collect your cup if you are unable to attend.
- Prizes may be collected from the Junior end of the marquee as soon as we have added up all the points!
- The winners will be displayed, and results also published on the website.

**The Junior exhibition is open to all to enjoy until 5:15 PM. When you may return to collect your work. Any exhibits not collected at the end of the day maybe thrown away (recycled!).**
