Classes and Categories

Pre-School

- 281 Olympic colours collage
- 282 Make an Olympic torch
- 283 An original painting – mounted on card
- 284 An original drawing – mounted on card

Reception

- 285 Paint the Olympic rings
- 286 Pointillism painting inspired by the artist Seurat
- 287 An original painting – mounted on card
- 288 An original drawing – mounted on card

Years 1 & 2

- 289 Make an Olympic medal
- 290 Make a van Gogh inspired sunflower
- 291 An original painting – mounted on card
- 292 An original drawing – mounted on card

Years 3 & 4

- 293 Make some bunting to celebrate the Olympics
- 294 Construct an Eiffel Tower
- 295 An original painting – mounted on card
- 296 An original drawing – mounted on card

Years 5 & 6

- 297 Picasso inspired 3D guitar picture
- 298 Make a mini café de Paris
- 299 An original painting – mounted on card
- 300 An original drawing – mounted on card

Years 7 – 9

- 301 Renoir inspired painting
- 302 Draw or paint an Olympic sport in action
- 303 An original drawing or painting – mounted on card

Years 10 & 11

- 304 Metro architecture inspired black and white drawing
- 305 Design and technology product (could be from a school project or GCSE)
- 306 An original drawing or painting – mounted on card

Open – Young photographer, baker, gardener and artist (pre-school to year 11)

- 307 Design and make an Olympic mascot
- 308 Painting/drawing inspired by Parisian buildings and architecture
- 309 Design an outfit inspired by Parisian fashion house (clothing could be made but won't be judged)
- 310 Grow a plant or place some flowers in a pot inspired by the Olympic colours (red, blue, yellow, green and black)
- 311 Make and decorate an Olympic inspired cake
- 312 A photograph of a landscape or seascape – mounted on card
- 313 A photograph of a living subject, human or animal – mounted on card
- 315 Design a poster for next year's Claygate Flower and Village Show 2025

Group Work -your choice of subject and medium. A group can be two or more children and individual points cannot be scored from these categories.

- 316 Pre-school children
- 317 Majority of group in Reception
- 318 Majority of group in Years 1 and 2
- 319 Majority of group in Years 3 and 4
- 320 Majority of group in Years 5 and 6
- 321 Majority of group in Years 7 – 9

322 Majority of group Years 10 and 11

330 Any age – garden produce grown by your group

Junior section: Points, Prizes and Cups

Point awarded: 1st = 10 points, 2nd = 8 points, 3rd = 6 points,

Highly commended = 4 points

Prizes: 1st prize £3, 2nd prize £2, 3rd prize £1

A cup to keep: awarded for the most points gained in each class.

The Junior Committee Cup: awarded for best overall contribution, to someone who has not otherwise been awarded a cup or trophy.

The Fawcus Cup: awarded to the school with the most first prizes.

The Brian Anscomb Cup: a commemorative cup for the best exhibit judge's opinion.

The CRGT Cup: best exhibit in the spirit of this year's theme, 'Paris & Olympics'.

Group Work Trophies: awarded for the best in each age range.

For preschool children, a certificate will be awarded instead of prize money.

For group work, certificates will be awarded instead of prize money.

Points to remember:

- Enter online at www.claygateflowershow.co.uk by 6:00 PM on Monday-8th July, 6.00 PM.
- Your exhibits should be brought to the Junior end of the marquee, between 8:00 AM and 10:00 AM on Saturday 13th July.
- Paper exhibits, pictures, photographs, poems need to be mounted on card so that we can display your work effectively. They may also be laminated.
- Write your name, school and phone number on the back of all exhibits.
- Only one entry allowed per person per Flower Show class.
- Exhibits created at home or school can be entered by individuals.
- Exhibits must not have been entered into the Flower Show from previous years.
- Please resist the urge to help your children too much, the judges do like to see the children's own work.
- Please stick to the description in the Categories. Entries can not be judged fairly and equally if the Category is not adhered to. If the Category is not followed said items can be displayed but may not be judged.
- Paintings are judged if the picture is painted using a brush (oil pastels are deemed to be paint)
- Drawings are judged if the picture is drawn using a pencil or pen (this includes felt tips)

Don't forget!

- All junior cups will be presented in the main arena at 4:00 PM.
- Please make sure that someone is at the arena to collect your cup if you are unable to attend.

- Prizes may be collected from the Junior end of the marquee as soon as we have added up all the points!
- The winners will be displayed, and results also published on the website.

The Junior exhibition is open to all to enjoy until 5:15 PM, when you may return to collect your work, any exhibits not collected at the end of the day maybe thrown away (recycled!).
